Skill

Go on Mission is being sent out by the Lord of the harvest into His harvest fields. We are anointed ambassadors to the unreached people of the world.

Design

Go on Mission (trailblazer) > The picture is a trailblazer hiking along a path into the wilderness illustrating the pioneer heartbeat of all missionaries. Yahweh's children cry out day and night for all peoples and the ends of the earth to be saved (Psalm 67). The **sketch** is a stick and travel bag illustrating the "go" command in the Great Commission to engage the ends of the earth with the gospel through prayer and fasting, giving, going, sending, and Internet discipleship (Matthew 28:19).

Story

Malta Island Miracles (Acts 28:1-10)

This story demonstrates Go on Mission as a kingdom skill because we clearly see Paul shipwrecked on an island of unengaged native people who did not know Yahweh or His Messiah. These indigenous peoples worshipped many gods, including a powerful demon named "Justice." Paul wanted them to know the gospel, so through prayers of faith and the power of the Holy Spirit, he was delivered from snake venom and healed many sick people as a sign that Jesus Christ's kingdom had come among the inhabitants of this remote island.

Scriptures


Psalm 96:3 > Declare Yahweh's glory among the nations, His wonderful works among all peoples.

Lesson Summary

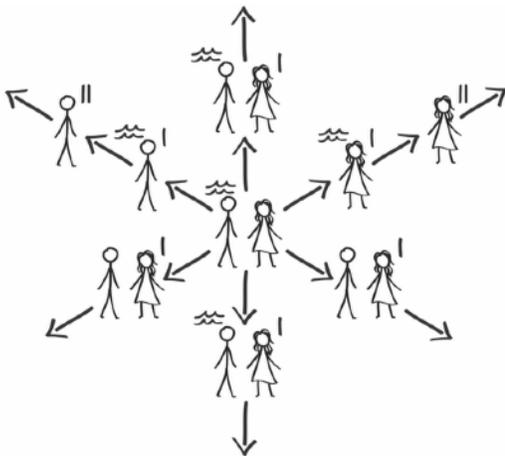
Go on Mission requires an adventurous spirit. Yahweh wants all of His children to have a passionate love for and a hunger and thirst to see every people group from all corners of the earth gathered together in redeemed love and joyful celebration (Isaiah 56:7). Daniel prophesied that all the earth will worship Jesus Christ and fall under His dominion (Daniel 7:14). Zephaniah prophesied that every people group will worship Yahweh in their own native lands (Zephaniah 2:11). Joel prophesied that the Spirit will be poured out on all people (Joel 2:28). Jesus commanded us to preach everywhere (Mark 16:15).

Gathering Guide



- Holy Spirit (fire): Let the Spirit guide your meeting.
- **Step One** (back arrow): Last week questions.
- Abide (worshipper): How did you abide last week?
- Harvest (witness): Whom did you share with?
- **Step Two** (up arrow): Discover this week's skill in Scripture as you discuss the Bible story.
- God (throne/crown): What do we learn about God?
- People (man/woman): What do we learn about people?
- Practice: Practice telling this week's story in groups.
- **Step Three** (forward arrow): Next week questions.
- Abide (heart): How will you abide?
- Harvest (fishing): Whom will you share with?

Generations Map



- People of Peace (people/arrows): Draw your disciples and their disciples. Share recent stories of how you and your team are engaging lost people.
- Baptism (waves): Update your map with those who have been baptized. What is the next step for each disciple who still needs to be baptized or become a baptizer by experience?
- Generations (number lines): Update your map with generations. How can we pray for this movement?
