Skill

Train Teachers is identifying and equipping teachers with an understanding of every Bible book, Israel's history and future, and stories for the nations.

Design

Train Teachers (fruit tree) > A fruit tree illustrates the foundation truth for every Bible teacher that God's Word is perfect and complete. Deep roots digging into the good soil of God's Word bears much fruit of thoughts, words, and actions. The **sketch** is a house built upon a solid rock foundation illustrating Jesus' teaching that our lives will only last if they are built upon His teaching.

Story

Kingdom Blessings (Matthew 5:1-12)

This story demonstrates Train Teachers as a kingdom skill because we clearly see Jesus setting apart significant time to teach the truth and wisdom of Yahweh's kingdom. Jesus' mountain message is short and deep, and the Master Teacher focuses on the Great Command (how to love God and love people) and the Great Commission (how to become His ambassadors to all nations). He anticipates questions and answers them with practical solutions.

Scriptures

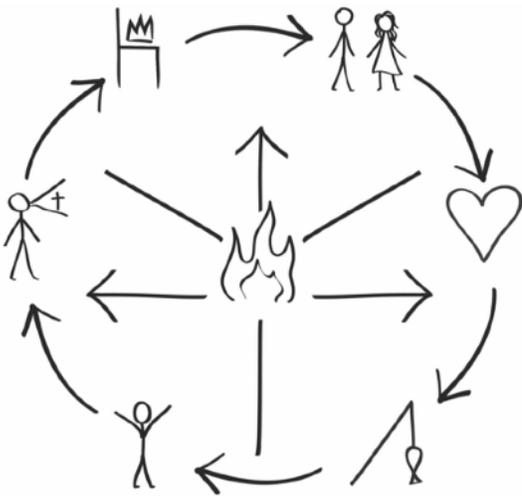
Acts 1:3 > After Jesus had suffered, He also presented Himself alive to His disciples by many convincing proofs, appearing to them during 40 days and teaching about the kingdom of God.

2 John 1:9 > Anyone who does not remain in Christ's teaching but goes beyond it, does not have God. The one who remains in that teaching, this one has both the Father and the Son.

Lesson Summary

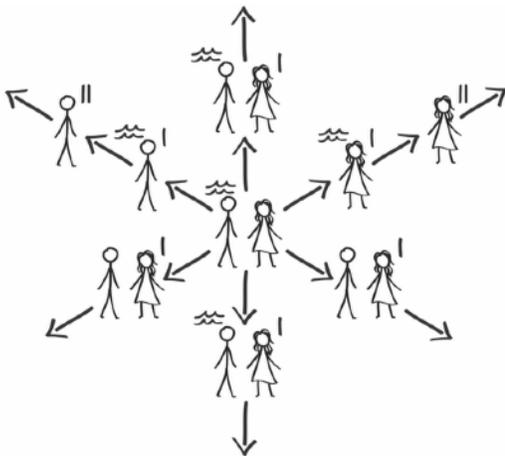
Train Teachers requires a devotion to meditating upon God's Word. The disciple who meditates day and night upon the words of life will always be fruitful and prosperous (Psalm 1:1-3). Teachers love to soak in God's Word and ponder whatever is true, honorable, just, pure, lovely, commendable, and excellent (Philippians 4:8-9). The signs of humble and Spirit-led teachers are wisdom, purity, peace, mercy, and servant leadership (James 3:13-18). The signs of prideful and hypocritical teachers are divisions, hierarchies, deceptions, flattery, and self-exaltation (Romans 16:17-18).

Gathering Guide



- Holy Spirit (fire): Let the Spirit guide your meeting.
- **Step One** (back arrow): Last week questions.
- Abide (worshipper): How did you abide last week?
- Harvest (witness): Whom did you share with?
- **Step Two** (up arrow): Discover this week's skill in Scripture as you discuss the Bible story.
- God (throne/crown): What do we learn about God?
- People (man/woman): What do we learn about people?
- Practice: Practice telling this week's story in groups.
- **Step Three** (forward arrow): Next week questions.
- Abide (heart): How will you abide?
- Harvest (fishing): Whom will you share with?

Generations Map



- People of Peace (people/arrows): Draw your disciples and their disciples. Share recent stories of how you and your team are engaging lost people.
- Baptism (waves): Update your map with those who have been baptized. What is the next step for each disciple who still needs to be baptized or become a baptizer by experience?
- Generations (number lines): Update your map with generations. How can we pray for this movement?
