



ACCELERATE MULTIPLICATION



Skill

Accelerate Multiplication is faithful and fruitful movement leadership. The more that existing leaders decrease, the more the Holy Spirit multiplies new leaders.

Design

Accelerate Multiplication (diversity whirlwind) > A rainbow whirlpool illustrates the natural diversity of strengths, passions, gifts, and personalities present in an accelerating movement of God. The **sketch** is blowing wind illustrating just how much control catalytic leaders actually have over God's movements: control is an illusion, just like grasping wind is impossible. The leader's role is a servant.

Story

How To Lead A Nation (Exodus 18:1-27)

This story demonstrates Accelerate Multiplication as a kingdom skill because we clearly see Yahweh send Jethro as His ambassador to train Moses in movement leadership mapping. God's plan for strengthening movements and accelerating multiplication is wrapped up in one principle: Do not lead alone. The potential for any movement to be fruitful and multiply depends completely upon how faithful the existing leaders are to cultivate a leadership community.

Scriptures

Proverbs 4:18 > The path of the righteous is like the light of dawn, shining brighter and brighter until midday.


Proverbs 4:20-23 > My son, pay attention to my words; listen closely to my advice. Do not lose sight of them; keep them within your heart. For they are

Lesson Summary


Accelerate Multiplication is diligently searching for where the Spirit of Jesus is already at work and devoting our time and resources to cultivate and multiply His kingdom coming His way in His timing. In Exodus 18, we see Jethro and Moses celebrate what God has already done, but also create a master plan to accelerate Yahweh's lordship among the Israelites. Jethro warned Moses not to bottleneck leadership authority and decision making, "What you're doing is not good. You will certainly wear out both yourself and these people who are with you, because the task is too heavy for you. You can't do it alone." To achieve No Place Left, the Lord requires every leader to release authority to many others.

Gathering Guide



- Holy Spirit (fire): Let the Spirit guide your meeting.
- **Step One** (back arrow): Last week questions.
- Abide (worshipper): How did you abide last week?
- Harvest (witness): Whom did you share with?
- **Step Two** (up arrow): Discover this week's skill in Scripture as you discuss the Bible story.
- God (throne/crown): What do we learn about God?
- People (man/woman): What do we learn about people?
- Practice: Practice telling this week's story in groups.
- **Step Three** (forward arrow): Next week questions.
- Abide (heart): How will you abide?
- Harvest (fishing): Whom will you share with?

Generations Map



- People of Peace (people/arrows): Draw your disciples and their disciples. Share recent stories of how you and your team are engaging lost people.
- Baptism (waves): Update your map with those who have been baptized. What is the next step for each disciple who still needs to be baptized or become a baptizer by experience?

- Generations (number lines): Update your map with generations. How can we pray for this movement?
