




PLANT A FOREST



Skill

Plant a Forest is making disciples who make disciples resulting in new generations and movements of baptized disciples and healthy churches.

Design

Plant a Forest (disciple making network) > God's plan for multiplication is mapped out in 2 Timothy 2:2, the 2-2-2 plan, where every disciple joins a harvest team, reaches the lost, and trains them to follow the same pattern. The **sketch** is also a disciple making network: every believer asks God to birth a healthy 4th generation movement through their prayers and witness.

Story

Kingdom Generation Tree (2 Timothy 2:1-7)

This story demonstrates Plant a Forest as a kingdom skill because we see the nature of kingdom ministry as suffering and hard work. Our greatest strength is the grace we receive from Jesus Christ. Our greatest calling is to love God and reveal His glory and majesty to the people around us. Our generation's prayer is for spiritual revival and restoration movements in our communities and cities. A soldier honors his officer, an athlete competes with integrity, and a farmer diligently labors from dawn to dusk until he can enjoy a fruitful harvest.

Scriptures

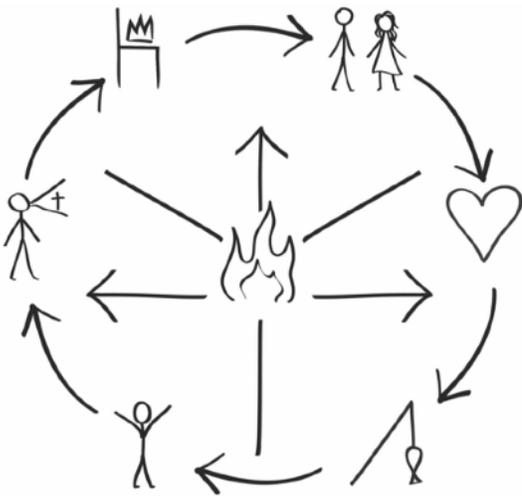

Lesson Summary


Plant a Forest begins with clear vision and a desperation for God to birth a healthy, multiplying movement. God's heart for His people has always been for us to be fruitful and multiply (Genesis 1:28). One day, the whole world will be overflowing with the worship and knowledge of Yahweh (Habakkuk 2:14). The greatest worship gathering awaits us in Zion city where disciples from every tribe, tongue, nation, and people will sing to and celebrate King Jesus (Revelation 7:9-10). Until then, we baptize new disciples among all nations and train them to obey all the Lord's commands (Matthew 28:16-20).

Gathering Guide



- Holy Spirit (fire): Let the Spirit guide your meeting.
- **Step One** (back arrow): Last week questions.
- Abide (worshipper): How did you abide last week?
- Harvest (witness): Whom did you share with?
- **Step Two** (up arrow): Discover this week's skill in Scripture as you discuss the Bible story.
- God (throne/crown): What do we learn about God?
- People (man/woman): What do we learn about people?
- Practice: Practice telling this week's story in groups.
- **Step Three** (forward arrow): Next week questions.
- Abide (heart): How will you abide?
- Harvest (fishing): Whom will you share with?

Generations Map



- People of Peace (people/arrows): Draw your disciples and their disciples. Share recent stories of how you and your team are engaging lost people.
- Baptism (waves): Update your map with those who have been baptized. What is the next step for each disciple who still needs to be baptized or become a baptizer by experience?
- Generations (number lines): Update your map with generations. How can we pray for this movement?
