John 15:1-17

Sketch #1: Vineyard keeper & vine - This sketch is the story logo. This sketch illustrates Father Yahweh as our caregiver and Jesus as the living water bridge to a fruitful life.

Sketch #2: Vine, branches, & fruit - This sketch illustrates Jesus as our Master and Source of Life. The fruitful branch is a disciple who remains in Jesus and obeys him.

Sketch #3: Burning branches - This sketch illustrates the Father cutting off branches unreceptive to living water. They burn up and are blown away, because they are dead.

Sketch #4: Crucified Christ - This sketch illustrates the love of Jesus for us: he gave his life as a sign of perfect love, and he invites his disciples to lay down their lives as well.

Gathering Guide



Rest (fire) - When we gather, our greatest need is to rest in our Father's heart. Share a meal, sing and pray, discuss your struggles, receive healing and encouragement. Rest refreshes and opens the door to receiving.

Receive (cloud & rainbow) - Next, we receive the Son: Yahweh's Word. We discuss the Bible together; growing into spiritual maturity, and strengthening our faith for spiritual warfare. Practice drawing the sketches and telling the story in your words.

Release (waves) - Now, we discuss our family, friends, neighbors, and the unreached here and around the world discerning by the Holy Spirit how to release spiritual gifts. Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you in next steps of obedience. What is the Holy Spirit revealing?
